Ask Him to show you the things that He would have you do for Him,

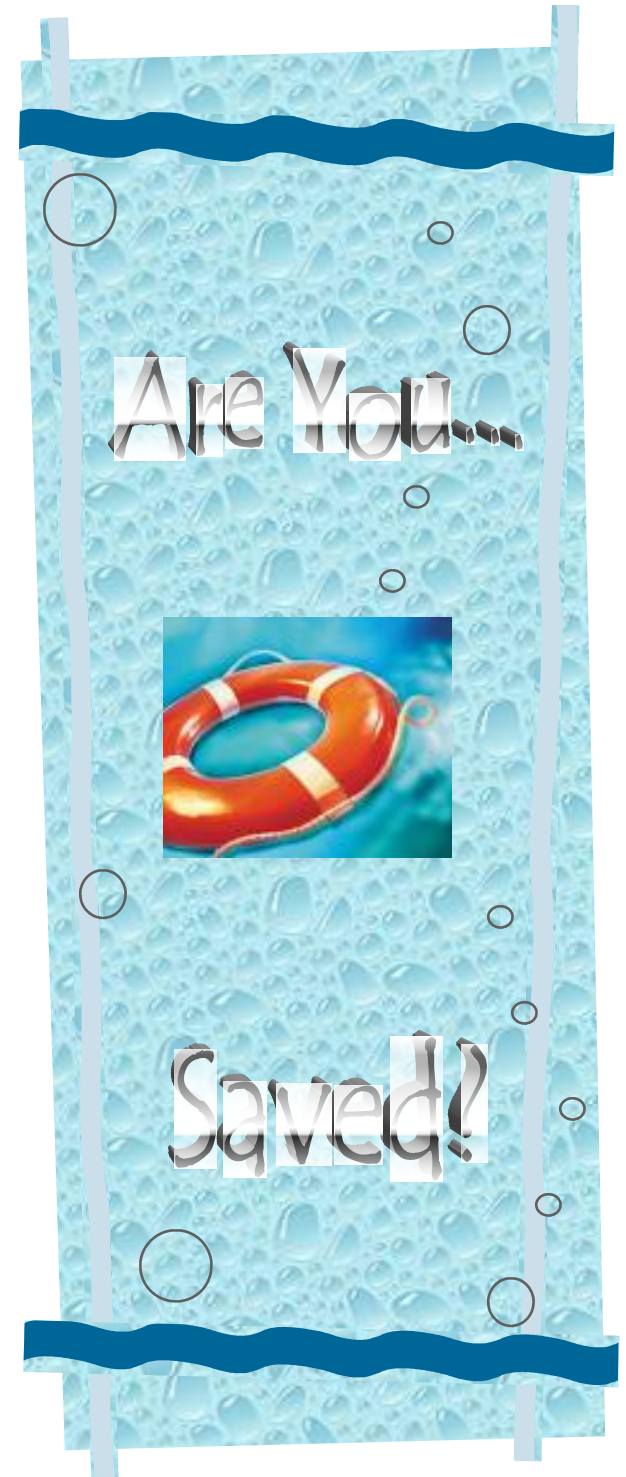
Tell Him you love Him!

Saved from what?

Saved from worries, fears, sadness, family problems, fair weather friends, troubles at work, drug or alcohol addictions. In today's ultra-modern, extremely complicated society, it has become very easy to fall into anyone of, or all of these traps.

The Bible tells us in 1st Peter 5:7, that we should be *“Casting all our care upon Him, for He cares for you.”*

You may be thinking that you have done so many wrong things in your life, that “there's no way that G~d would have anything to do with me”.



Nothing could be further from the truth!

We see in the Bible, that Yeshua (Hebrew for Jesus) associated with people like fisherman, tax collectors and other people that were considered Sinners.

The Bible tells us in 1st Timothy 2:4 *“That G~d desires all men to be saved and come to the knowledge of the truth.”*

We are also told in Luke 19:10 *“For the Son of man has come to seek that which was lost.”*

Who is this “Son of man” that we ate told about here? It is Yeshua Ha Mashiach! (Jesus the Messiah)
